## APPLICANTS' F.A.Q.

### ***What documents are needed to enter the NUS?***

The applicants themselves apply for enrolment on the NUS; the state standard document of the senior secondary education (of the received educational qualification level) and its appendix (either the original, or the certified copy, at your option); medical certificate 086-o (the original or the certified copy); 6 colour photos (3 x 4 cm); the Certificate of the Ukrainian Education Quality Testing Centre (UEQTC) with grades at the disciplines for enrolment exams chosen with the NUS Enrolment Regulations; your identification code copy; your passport (birth certificate); military card (certificate of draft office registration); benefits documents; your own pieces of work for the "Design" field; the documents proving your sports level and passing the medical board for the "Sports" field.

### ***What should I do if the UEQTC results hadn't come till July 15?***

The enrolment document is the certificate received at the testing registration. The received grades can be given as a copy of your own page at the UEQTC web-site. The testing results will be checked obligatorily by the Admissions Office.

### ***How many specialities can be applied for at the same time?***

Not more than 3 fields for enrolment on competitive basis can be applied for at the same time.

### ***May the education certificate copy be given?***

If an applicant files any document copies, he / she should show their originals. The applicants to take part in the enrolment competition of several higher educational institutions have to file the original documents to the NUS Admissions Office at the stated time (5 days) after the list of entrants according to the state order has been announced.

### ***Is the certificate mark taken into account enrolling on the NUS?***

The average mark of the senior secondary education certificate (12-point rating) is taken into account for those who have senior secondary education and enrol to obtain the educational qualification level of Bachelor. The mark is rounded to 1 decimal place.

### ***What is the pass mark for a school-leaver to enrol on the NUS?***

The National University of Shipbuilding accepts the certificates with not less than 124 points of the 200-point rating. The certificates under this demand are not accepted.

### ***Are there any privileged categories of applicants?***

By results of the interview the applicants who are given this right in accordance with the Law of Ukraine "On the Status and Social Security of the Citizens who Had Suffered from Chernobyl Disaster" enter university.

Hors concours after having filed the UEQTC certificates with points over 124 such categories of applicants enter university:

- those who are given this right according to the Law of Ukraine "On the Status of War Veterans, the Guaranties of Their Social Security";
- orphans and children without parents' custody, orphans and children without parents' custody aged 18-23;
- disabled persons of I and II disability groups and disabled children under 18;
- those who are given this right in accordance with the Law of Ukraine "On the Status and Social Security of the Citizens who Had Suffered from Chernobyl Disaster";
- children of the military people of the Armed Forces of Ukraine, other military units, of law-enforcement bodies workers, who died officiating.

The people listed enrol on university hors concours if they file the original UEQTC certificates and other documents proving the right of enrolment hors concours.

### ***Who is given the right of enrolment without competitive examination?***

Without competitive examination those are enrolled who are:

- the international contests participants;
- winners (those who were awarded with I-III-degree diplomas) of IV stage of the All-Ukrainian pupils contests in core subjects.

They are enrolled if they file the UEQTC certificates with not less than 124 points and if the core subject of the field (speciality) they apply for is that one in which they are winners.
